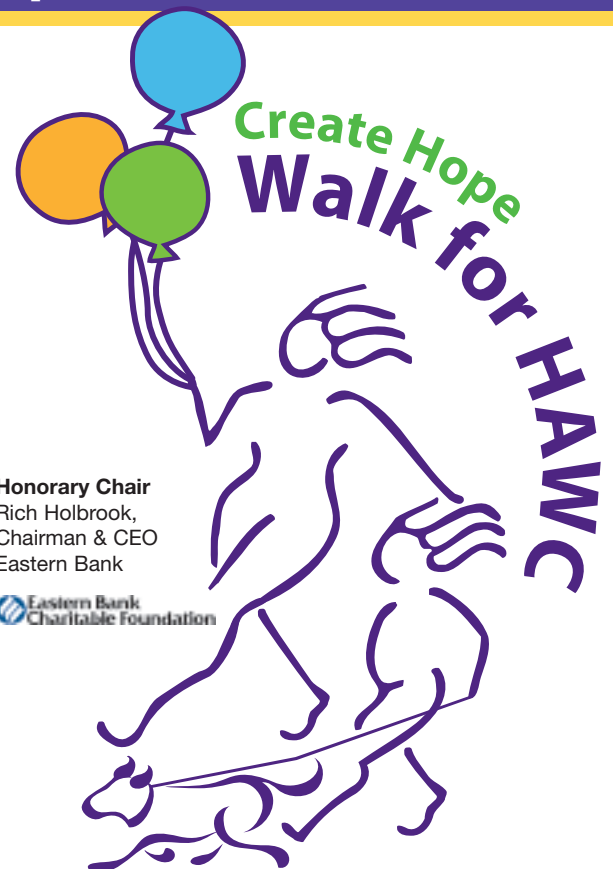

## Directions to the Walk for HAWC

The Walk for HAWC is a fun way to make a real difference in your community

### Directions to Old Town Hall in Salem, MA:

**FROM THE SOUTH:** Head North on Route 128. Exit onto Route 114 (Exit 25) – (You will see the Northshore Mall on your left as you approach exit 25). Follow Route 114 East for about 2 miles into Salem. Cross over the bridge (HMA car wash is on your left). Take a right just after the bridge. At the end of the exit ramp turn right onto Bridge St. (going under Route 114.) At the top of the hill is a rotary. Turn right at the rotary on to Washington Street. Turn left at the next light (Derby Street intersection). At the next intersection there will be a fire station on your left. Turn left at that light on to Lafayette Street, and then take your next left on to Front Street. Old Town Hall is on Front Street on your right.

**FROM BEVERLY:** Follow Route 1A over the bridge, bearing left at the light onto Bridge Street. Follow Bridge St. through 3 sets of traffic lights. Turn left on to Winter Street, staying on Route 1A. Follow 1A to Derby Street. Turn right on Derby to the next traffic light. There will



be a fire station on your right. Turn right at that light on to Lafayette Street, and then take your next left on to Front Street. Old Town Hall is on Front Street on your right.

**PARKING:** Free parking is available at the South Harbor Garage on the corner of Derby and Congress Streets and the open lot behind museum place (see map). All other service lots and meters are free on Sundays.

**RIDE THE T:** Ride from North Station or from points north to Salem Station. Follow Washington Street to Front Street. Turn left on Front Street to Old Town Hall.

**REGISTRATION:** Register between 11 am and 12 noon at Old Town Hall in downtown Salem. Come early to avoid long lines. The Walk steps off at 12 pm, rain or shine, beginning and ending at Old Town Hall.
